How is it assessed?

The NEBOSH General Certificate is split into two units which are assessed individually:

- NG1: An open book digital examination to assess what you know. This is scenario based and will include a closing interview in which the delegate will be asked questions about their submission. Learners will have 24 hours to assess, complete and submit their paper starting from 11am (UK time) on the exam date. Pass mark is 45.
- NG2: A practical risk assessment to assess what the learner can do (3 hours). Learners will complete a risk assessment and develop an action plan for their workplace – this is immediately useful and valuable.
